



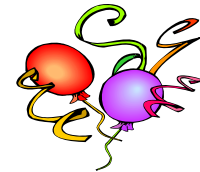

Life does what it does and his life got a little bumpy...he got loaded. Quickly. Nobody there to lean on. No Conscious Contact with that HP. Just a dark room and mind full of fear. It's inevitable. When the obsession to use returns, you will use. All of us will. That's why the BB says on page 43, "Once more: The alcoholic at certain times has no effective mental defense against the first drink. Except in a few rare cases, neither he nor any other human being can provide such a defense. His defense MUST come from a higher power."

Always amazes me that we will spend all that time and money to come to treatment, only to leave and do things "our way" one more time. The frustrating part for all of us is "our way" can work for a while! Right up till that 'ol obsession kicks in again! Then we are sunk. The way out of this mess is the same for all of us. So many of us seem to be finding a nice hiding place at step 2. "I'm having trouble with step 2". For most of us that's just plain rubbish. How long can we wrestle with one question? Do you

believe there's something out there bigger than you? "Well...yes." THEN LET'S GET ON WITH THE WORK!! Nowhere in the book does it say ya gotta get GOD all figured out before you can proceed. Nowhere. Isn't the truth that you're just a bit LAZY and you're trying to put off the inevitable? I think so.

Stop trying to do this yourself. That's probably the one biggest theme in all these stupid articles I write. Life starts to throw ya some curves, pick up the phone and call some recovery folks.
